

Excerpts from a letter written by 2018 Kismet graduate, Bryanna Alley, who continues to be involved with Kismet as a house staff.

I grew up in a difficult and abusive home. My mother's death when I was six years old was just the beginning of a long series of challenges I have faced. After her death, my father's anger issues manifested...this abuse caused my siblings and me to be placed in foster care. As an 8th grader, already having to face the struggles and difficulties of middle school, this was crushing. **But, in middle school, I was lucky enough to attend the Kismet presentation - something that would change my life forever.**

Kismet is near and dear to my heart. It sparked a confidence in me and gave me a feeling of worth - things I did not have as a child. It was a place I felt most supported and cared for. It was an escape from the reality of life. It's my happy place. Kismet has taught me so many things about life, but most importantly about myself.


Growing up...I did not believe in myself. Kismet, in many ways, changed that for me. Climbing taught me many things and provided me skills I use every day.

By pushing myself and completing harder climbs, I proved to myself that I was capable of more than I thought. This has helped me in my life because I have been able to continue pushing myself and growing.

I have built friendships that will last a lifetime at Kismet. The bond that my group has is one that will never break...I know that at any point in my life, I can call anyone I have met through the organization and they will be there for me. That's just how it is.

I believe my most important takeaway from Kismet is the confidence I grew there. It taught me what being happy and feeling love is truly like. Kismet is one of the most important things in my life, and I cannot wait to spend my summers on the other side - helping and changing lives through Kismet, just like it did for me.
